

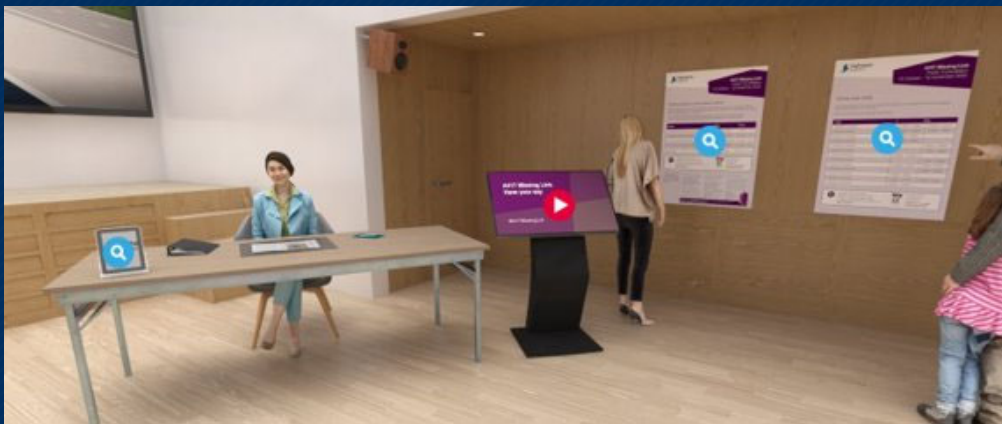
Project Update – Statutory Consultation: 24 September – 6 November
